I was sitting in the doctor's waiting room while Denise was at an appointment one time when I came across something in the "Reader's Digest" that caught my eye. It was the phrase '940 Saturdays'.

You may only have 940 Sundays. How will you spend the one coming up?

OLD BUSINESS:

Worship Bags - Jessica update

Jessica not present. Discussion about sticks. Those present discussed that they observe most children NOT using the sticks appropriately. The consensus is that the sticks be removed. Additionally, there were concerns about the strings and that they also be removed. Also discussed trading out Easter items. All other parts in the bags are fantastic and much appreciated! Suggested add was coloring pages vs. plain paper.

VBS Report- Keri Kearns

SCUBA VBS was 7/27 - 8/1, with performance during worship on 8/4. Keri reported an average attendance of 40-45 children each evening. Feedback from those present was VBS went really smoothly and it was a success. The family style meal went great, most kids had at least one family member attend with only 1-2 kids being dropped off alone. Jenny Ross reported food went great and there is leftover hot dogs, buns and taco meat. Snacks were not needed because everyone got plenty to eat. Keri reported she saved approximately \$150 on curriculum and supplies by working with Argyle Methodist and she has ideas to save more money next year. T-shirts were again our biggest expense coming in \$648, with only 6 shirts extra and every attendee, helper getting a shirt. Only had 3 no shows (didn't attend any night). \$512 was collected at VBS and will be donated to the The Food Bank for Central and Northeast Missouri for Buddy Packs.

Youth Group

13 youth attended and report it was a fantastic experience - 7/22-7/26. The only cost to participants was the \$50 deposit for their spot. The rest was covered by fundraiser (lunch for donation prepared on church workday 6/9) and consistory covered the rest of the cost. The attendees discussed their experience at the church service on 7/28. It was requested that the youth do a short write up about camp and a thank you for church newsletter Keri Kearns will facilitate, work with Cristian to obtain.

Youth group will resume meeting 8/28/24 time will be 5:30 or 6-8pm per Cristian. Bible Dedication/4th Grade

Two students Kamden Rodgers and Lexi Sturm will receive their Bibles on 9/8 during worship. Chrissy will wrap and Pastor will do the dedication. Bibles dropped off at Industrial Opportunities 8/1 for engraving but their machine was down. Chrissy will follow up with Indust. Opp. to check on progress. Pastor will do an inscription before wrapping per usual. Follow up 8/16: Machine still down, promised they will be done next week.

Emily discussed this at May meeting, she was going to further develop over summer. Item tabled.

Sunday School Classes needs/wants - increase attendance:

Chrissy discussed concerns that with just 4th grade having two students and 5th grade having one, again it may not be feasible to teach with Safe sanctuary standards and to the comfort of the one maybe two sometimes kids who would attend most, sometimes. This prompted discussion of shifting/ shuffling classes to cover the eb and flow of various size grade groups. It was expressed that Wanda had wanted to retire from teaching. Proposed is Nolene covering PreK-1st and Jan, Chrissy cover 2-5. Ava will follow up with Wanda, Chrissy will follow up with Jan. UPDATE: Wanda has decided to retire (appropriate celebration of her years of service to follow) and Jan was agreeable to working with Chrissy covering grades 2-5. Chrissy and Jan will make current curriculum purchased for her room work.
